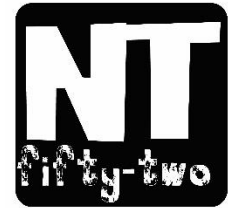


## Nehemiah Teams 2018 Global City Outreach Team

### **Clothing**

- Daily Ministry clothes (pants/jeans/capris/shorts/skirts) with clean shirt. Typical attire  
Guys: pants with a polo or t-shirt. Girls: pants with short sleeve shirt.
- One “smart casual” outfit for special occasions (wedding), go to mosque, church, etc
- underwear, socks
- sleep clothes
- modest swimwear (Guys: No Speedos. Girls No bikinis)
- Athletic gear: If you enjoy this type of activity, bring a couple sets (optional)
- Shoes: Comfortable walking shoes or sandals. Most houses require that you take off footwear before entering.

### **Other important items**

- Bible/discipleship materials/journal
- Towel & washcloth (lightweight, quick dry is good)
- *Spiritual Warfare* book
- Additional ID other than passport (driver’s license/student ID/etc)
- 2 xerox copies of your passport bio page
- small backpack or sling bag for daily use. (You will be walking & using public transportation daily & will need something to carry what you need for the day with you.)
- list of important phone numbers/email addresses/ mailing addresses
- Sunglasses
- Personal pillow (optional)
- Camera
- Toiletries (bring a small amount & you can buy more)
- prescription medicines- 2 month supply, you may not be able to get it here
- pictures of family & friends to show
- small gifts to give away (candy, stickers, keychains of your home state, etc.)
- electricity converter/adaptor (optional)

### **Packing information**

- Nehemiah Team/Project 52 members will receive a duffle bag/backpack to use for the summer. A deposit/usage fee is included in your field expense budget. You will pick up this bag when you arrive at orientation and re-pack your things. There will be room to store your original bag & extra items over the course of the summer. This will be your checked piece of luggage. In addition you can have a carry-on (weighing less than 15 lbs.). Bag capacity: 70 liters or 4300 cubic inches.
- If you are required to bring specific equipment or asked to bring personal items for supervisor, these can be packed in a 2nd piece of checked luggage. Good idea to pack these as a team after arriving at orientation.

### **General guidelines for clothing**

- You will be working in an urban setting.
- Team members will wear long pants or nice shorts & clean shirts during ministry time.
- Sleeveless shirts are not permitted for guys or girls. (This includes tank tops.)
- No military-type clothing or accessories. No camo hats, bags, shirts or pants.
- If you not sure if something would be appropriate, please ask your supervisor.

### **Orientation/debrief items**

- All teams will need personal eating utensils for orientation/debrief: plate, bowl, cup, silverware
- All teams will need bedding during orientation/debrief: self-inflating sleeping pad, sheet, small pillow
- All teams will be bathing outdoors during orientation/debrief. All will need their own towel as well as dark colored shorts & shirts to wear while bathing.

If these items aren't needed on the field there will be a place for you to store them over the summer, ready for you when you return for debrief.
