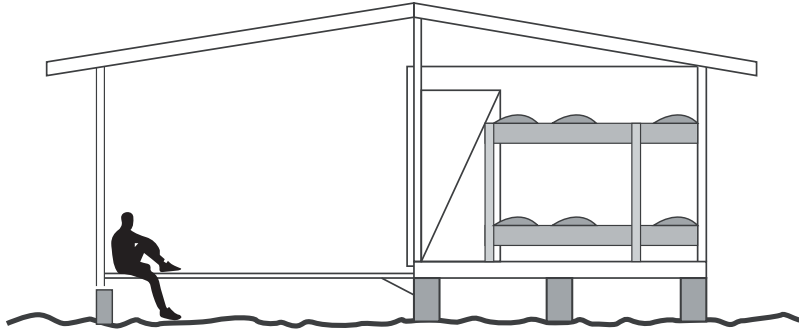
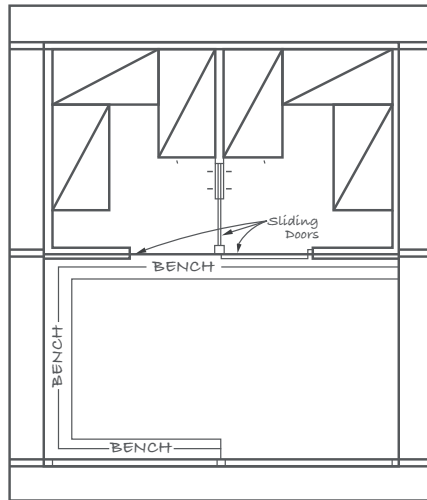

What is Nehemiah Teams?

An 8-week summer mission opportunity for Southern Baptists ages 17-29 that strategically involves young people in cross-cultural missions to unreached people groups internationally or here in the United States (Project 52).

What is AOT?

Nehemiah Teams Advance Operations Training (AOT) is designed to disciple, develop, and deploy this generation to finish the Great Commission in this generation, specifically preparing young people to accept different leadership roles and assignments needed for NT.

This training will also better prepare them for longer term assignments or lifetime appointments with the IMB.

When does AOT Begin?

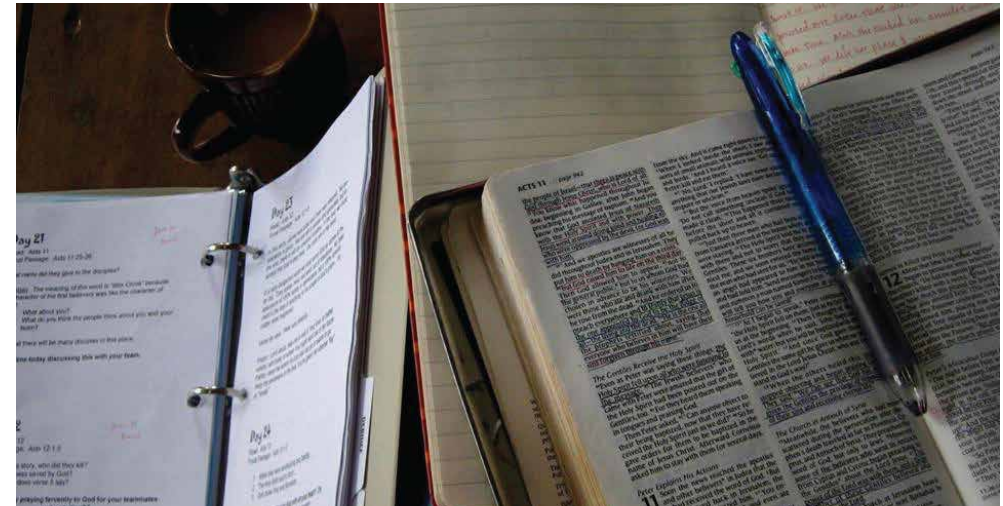
At the beginning of each college semester (Jan & Aug). AOT includes a 4 month training phase and a 2 month deployment with Nehemiah Teams or Project 52.






Where is the Nehemiah Teams Training Center?
